E. Raddatz, his heirs, personal representatives or assigns, the royalties due the Assignee under this Assignment.

Raddatz, his heirs, personal representatives, successors and assigns, a one (1%) per cent of all oil and/or gas or other hydrocarbons that may be produced and sold from the lands hereinabove described, as an overriding royalty, free of cost to assignee herein.

It is agreed that this instrument or a certified copy thereof shall constitute authority to the holder of the oil and gas lease covering the above described land or any purchaser of the oil and/or gas produced therefrom, to pay to H. E. Raddatz, his heirs, personal representatives or assigns, the royalties due the Assignee under this Assignment.
