DECREE OF SETTLEMENT OF ACCOUNT AND FINAL DISTRIBUTION

Jean G. Adney, Administratrix of the estate of Ben J. Adney, having on or about the 5 day of May, 1944, rendered and filed herein a full account and report of her administration of said estate, which account was for final settlement, and having with said account filed a petition for the final distribution of said estate.

And said account and petition this day coming on regularly to be heard, proof having been made to the satisfaction of the Court that Notice of the settlement of said account and hearing of said petition has been given in accordance with the laws of the State of Wyoming, and that proof thereof has been filed herein.

And it appearing that said account is in all respects true and correct and that all claims filed in said estate and all debts of decedent, all taxes on said estate, including inheritance taxes and all debts, expenses and charges of administration, except as herein-after stated, have been fully paid and discharged, and that said estate is ready for distribution. That the Court costs amount to and are taxed at \$17.30.

And the Court finds that on September 30, 1943, first publication of Notice to Creditors of said estate was published and thereafter said publication was continued for the time and in the manner provided by law, proof of which publication was filed with the Clerk of this Court, and the Court finds that an Inventory and Appraisement of said estate was made and filed herein by said Administratrix.
