D E C R E E

The petition of Lorilla Smith coming on regularly this day for hearing, and it appearing that the petition herein was set for hearing by Order made herein for August 20th, 1945, at ten o'clock A.M., or as soon thereafter as the matter might be heard, and that notice thereof was published in Green River Star, a legal newspaper of general circulation in Sweetwater County, in its issues of July 27th, August 3rd, August 10th and August 17th, 1945, proof of which publication has been made and filed herein; and it appearing that notice of the hearing of said petition has been given in all things as prescribed by law, and petitioner appearing in support of her petition, and no person appearing in opposition thereto, and witnesses being sworn and testified herein, the Court doth say and find as follows:

That John Nelson died on November 10th, 1927; that he left No Will, and that at the time of his death he was a resident of the County of Sweetwater and State of Wyoming; that more than two years have elapsed since the date of the death of the deceased, and that he died seized of an interest in lands in the State of Wyoming, described as follows:

West Half of the Southeast Quarter, the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter and the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section thirty-five in Township Twenty-seven North of Range One Hundred Five West of the Sixth Principal Meridian, Wyoming, containing one hundred sixty acres.

The Court further finds that there has been no record judicial determination of the decedent's heirs or of the right of descent from him in his real property;

The Court further finds that on November 10th, 1927, the date of decedent's death, he left his widow, Lorilla Nelson, now Lorilla Smith, petitioner herein, his son, Glen Nelson, and his daughter, Ethlyn Nelson, now Ethlyn Forshaw, and that he left him surviving no other children nor the descendants of any deceased children.

WHEREFORE, IT IS CONSIDERED, ORDERED AND DECREED that the said John Nelson died on November 10th, 1927, that he left him surviving his widow, Lorilla Nelson, who has remarried and who is now Lorilla Smith, his son, Glen Nelson, and his daughter, Ethlyn Nelson, now Ethlyn Forshaw, who are his only heirs, and that their right of descent of and to the real property of the decedent is as follows:

The said Lorilla Smith, an undivided one-half interest,
The said Glen Nelson, an undivided one-fourth interest,
The said Ethlyn Forshaw, an undivided one-fourth interest.
