

The Court doth further find; that the plaintiff, Mildred Jensen, died on the 24th day of August, 1943, before judgement was rendered by this Court in this action; AND

The Court doth further find; that Albert Larson and James P. Jensen, by order of this Court, were appointed executors of the last will and testament of said Mildred Jensen, on the 28th day of October, 1943, and now are the executors thereof, AND

The Court doth further find; that by order of this Court, this action was revived, and said executors were substituted in the name, place and stead of said plaintiff, Mildred Jensen, on the 18th day of January, 1944; AND

The Court doth further find; that the Plaintiff, Mildred Jensen, was at other times known as Mildred Mickelson Jensen; AND

The Court doth further find; that Ivan S. Jones, Esq., a member of the State Bar of Wyoming, was appointed to represent said defaulting defendants; AND

The Court having heard the evidence adduced by Plaintiffs and being now fully advised in the premises does find generally in favor of Plaintiffs and against Defendants, and that Plaintiffs are entitled to a judgement and decree against said Defendants, and against each and all of them, quieting title in Plaintiffs and against said defendants, and each and all of them, in and to the real property as described in said petition, and as herein after described:

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED, that at the commencement of this action, Mildred Jensen, sometimes known as Mildred Mickelson Jensen, now deceased, was the plaintiff herein and was seized in fee simple of all the premises hereinafter described, and the substituted Plaintiffs, Albert Larson and James P. Jensen, are now in possession of said premises; that the defendants have not, nor have any of them, any estate, right, title, claim or interest, in or to the same, or to any part thereof; and that the title of Plaintiffs hereto be, and the same hereby is, quieted, in said plaintiff's and as against the Defendants, and each of them, is hereby forever enjoined, debarred, and restrained from bringing any action against Plaintiffs or their successors, in regard to Plaintiff's title or possession of said real property, and from asserting or claiming any estate, right, title, or interest in or to the said real property adversely to Plaintiffs.

The following is the description of the real property to which title is hereby quieted in Plaintiffs:
