KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That THE TEXAS COMPANY (formerly named The Texas Corporation), a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Delaware, and having authority to transact business in the States of Colorado, Idaho, Montana, Nebraska, North Dakota, South Dakota, Utah, and Wyoming, acting herein by and through R. Ogarrio, its Vice President, who is hereunto duly authorized, has this day made, constituted and appointed, and by these presents does make, constitute and appoint H. A. STEWART, of the City and County of Denver, Colorado the true and lawful agent and attorney-in-fact of said The Texas Company, for it and in its name, place and stead; to contract for and purchase lands in any of the following States, to wit: Colorado, Idaho, Montana, Nebraska, North Dakota, South Dakota, Utah, and/or Wyoming, and oil, gas or other mineral fees and oil, gas, or other royalty interests in or affecting lands in any of said States; to contract for, acquire and/or execute leases, subleases or federal oil and gas prospecting permits covering lands in any of said States with such terms, covenants and stipulations as he may deem proper; to apply to the Department of the Interior for oil and gas prospecting permits, or oil and gas leases, upon federal public domain in any of said States, and to execute all bonds, affidavits, and showings necessary or proper in connection therewith; to enter into operating agreements whereby said The Texas Company, as operator, shall develop and/or operate for oil and/or gas federal, State or privately owned lands in any of said States with such terms, covenants and stipulations as he may deem proper; to surrender any lease, sublease, or prospecting permit in favor of, or any operating agreement with, said The Texas Company on lands in any of said States to let or sublet any lands in any of said States for and on its behalf; to contract for the drilling of wells on lands in any of said States in which said The Texas Company is interested; to negotiate and execute contracts for the sale of oil and gas (including casinghead gas) owned by said The Texas Company and produced in any of said States; when specially authorized by telegram or letter from the President or any Vice President of said The Texas Company, but not otherwise, to grant, bargain, sell convey and/or assign any lands, or leases, subleases, prospecting permits, mineral fees, or royalty interests in or affecting lands, in any of said States belonging to said The Texas Company; to receive, receipt for and collect such sums of money as may be due and payable to said The Texas Company by virtue of any transaction which said agent and attorney-in-fact shall have had under and by virtue of these presents; to execute all
