All her interest in and to the following described property:

Approximately 75 head of cattle branded K1 on left ribs, approximately 12 head or horses branded K1 on left shoulder, and using as the base, the place commonly known as the former Thomas King place, approximately ten (10) miles South of Boulder, Wyoming. It being my intention to convey all my right, title and interest in and to all cattle, horses and machinery owned by me; together with all my interest, in all grazing and forest rights; also all my interest in and to the brand shown as follows: K1
