King the party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does by these presents, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns,

All her interest in and to the following described property:

Approximately 75 head of cattle branded K⁹ on left ribs, approximately 12 head or horses branded K⁹ on left shoulder, and using as the base, the place commonly known as the former Thomas King place, approximately ten (10) miles South of Boulder, Wyoming. It being my intention to convey all my right, title and interest in and to all cattle, horses and machinery owned by me; together with all my interest, in all grazing and forest rights; also all my interest in and to the brand shown as follows: K⁹
