McKinney; and being fully advised in the premises, finds generally in favor of the plaintiff and against the defendant, and that she should be awarded a decree of divorce from the defendant;

IT IS, THEREFORE, FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the plaintiff Hilda Hazel Gorey be and she hereby is awarded a decree of absolute divorce from the defendant Frank Gorey, and the bonds of matrimony between them are vacated, set aside and held for naught.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Lot 14, Block 18 in the Town of Pinedale, Sublette County, Wyoming, being the property of the Plaintiff and defendant, be and the same is hereby set over and conveyed to the plaintiff Hilda Hazel Gorey, as her absolute property.
