DECREE OF SETTLEMENT OF ACCOUNT AND FINAL DISTRIBUTION

Hannah P. Jensen, Executrix of the Last Will and Testament of Martin Jensen, sometimes known as Metinus Jensen, deceased, having on or about the 20th day of August, 1947, rendered and filed herein a full account and report of her administration of said estate, which account was for final settlement, and having with said account filed a Petition for Distribution of said estate,

And said account and petition coming on this day regularly to be heard, proof having been made to the satisfaction of the Court, that notice of the settlement of said account and the hearing of said petition has been given in accordance with the laws of Wyoming and that proof thereof has been filed herein.

And it appearing that said account is in all respects true and correct; that no claims have been filed in said estate and that all debts of the deceased, and all taxes, including inheritance taxes, and all expenses and charges of administration have been paid; that no Court costs are unpaid and that said estate is now ready for distribution,

And the Court finds that Notice to Creditors of said estate was published for the time end in the manner provided by law, the first publication being on February 6, 1947, and that proof of said publication was filed with the Clerk of this Court, and that more than six months have elapsed since the first publication thereof; and the Court further finds that an Inventory and Appraisement of said estate was filed herein by said Executrix, Hannah P. Jensen,

And it appearing that said Executrix has paid her attorney the sum of \$620.00 for the services rendered by him in the probate of this estate said sum is allowed and approved by the Court.

And the Court being advised in the premises, it is Ordered, Adjudged and Decreed that the final account of Hannah P. Jensen, Executrix, filed herein be in the same is hereby settled, allowed and approved.

And the Court finds that the said Martin Jensen, a resident of Sublette County, Wyoming, died testate on the 5th day of November, 1946, and that his Last Will and Testament duly and regularly admitted to probate in this Court provided, insofar as applicable to this distribution as follows:

"1. I first direct that all my just debts and funeral expenses be paid out of my estate as soon as practicable after the time of my decease.

2. I give, devise, bequeath all the rest, residue and remainder of my property, real, personal and mixed and wherever situate and located to my wife, Hannah P. Jensen."

And the Court finds that the said Hannah P. Jensen was and is the sole legatee and devisee under the Last Will and Testament of Martin Jensen, deceased, and is entitled to the distribution of his entire estate.

And the Court further finds that there is on hand and available for distribution to the said Hannah P. Jensen pursuant to the provisions of the Last Will and Testament of Martin Jensen, the property, premises and assets hereinafter described, provided however that the property, premises and assets hereinafter described and all thereof was on the 5th day of October, 1945, prior to the death of the said Martin Jensen, sold under a Contract of Sale to Otto F. Jensen and Florence Jensen, husband and wife, together with other property owned individually
