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NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and the promises herein contained, the parties hereto commit to this agreement their respective interests in the unit area and agree severally among themselves as follows:

ENABLING ACT AND REGULATIONS

1. The act of February 25, 1920, as amended, supra, and all valid pertinent regulations, including operating and unit plan regulations, heretofore issued thereunder or valid pertinent and reasonable regulations hereafter issued thereunder are accepted and made a part of this agreement as to all Federal lands, and as to non-Federal land applicable laws of the State of Wyoming are accepted and made a part of this agreement.

UNIT AREA

2. The lands hereby designated and recognized as constituting the unit area are all of the lands embraced within the heavy black line delineated on the map entitled "Pinedale Unit Plan," hereto annexed, marked Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof. It is understood and agreed that the lands now made subject to this agreement on its effective date shall be listed by Unit Operator as committed lands in Exhibit "B", hereto annexed, when this Unit Agreement is submitted for final approval, and that the remaining lands in the Unit Area also shall be listed in said Exhibit "B", but shall be regarded as not committed hereto unless and until made subject to this agreement as provided in Section 13 hereof. If any such remaining lands are so made subject to this agreement, not less than six copies of a revised Exhibit "B" showing all lands then committed hereto shall be filed with the Oil and Gas Supervisor, hereinafter called "Supervisor", and two copies with the Commissioner of Public Lands of Wyoming. Exhibits "A" and "B" shall both be revised whenever changes in the Unit Area or other changes render such revision necessary, and not less than six copies of each Exhibit shall be filed with the Supervisor and two copies with the Commissioner of Public Lands of Wyoming.

The above-described unit area shall be organized or contracted, whenever such action is necessary or desirable to conform with the purposes of this agreement, in the following manner: (a) Unit Operator, on its own motion or on demand of the Director of the Geological Survey, hereinafter referred to as Director, shall prepare a notice of proposed expansion or contraction describing the contemplated changes in the boundaries of the unit area, the reasons therefor, and the proposed effective date thereof.
