

of said parties, either being an original owner or a successor in interest of the original owners, shall have in said enlargement of said Reservoir shall be the same proportionate interest as was determined by the Supreme Court with reference to their interest in the original Reservoir Permit and the right to use the waters of Lake Creek and Willow Lake, and

IT IS FURTHER SPECIFICALLY AGREED Dean Binning, being the successor in interest of Burleigh Binning, Deceased, shall, and does have a 55% interest in said enlargement Permit No. 4475 Reservoir even though his name nor that of his predecessor in interest does not appear as one of the applicants for said enlargement permit.

IT IS FURTHER SPECIFICALLY AGREED that this instrument, when executed by the parties hereto, shall stand as unconditional acknowledgment of the interests of the parties in said enlargement permit and the enlarged reservoir, when constructed, and for all purposes shall be unconditionally accepted as evidence of said ownership.
