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in the trial of said action, and authorized and directed him to appear and defend said action in behalf of said defendants, said appointment having been made pursuant to the provision of the Soldier's and Sailors' Relief Act; that the said Paul Ziegler by virtue of said appointment, has filed an answer herein, admitting some and denying other allegations of plaintiff's petition.

3. That the attorney for plaintiff has also filed herein an affidavit for and in behalf of plaintiff stating that the residence of defendant, John B. Westman is unknown, and cannot with reasonable diligence be ascertained, and that the names and residences of the heirs, devisees and creditors of said John. B. Westman and all persons unknown claiming an estate or interest in, or lien upon, the real property, which is the subject of this action, and particularly described in said petition, are still unknown to the plaintiff and his attorney, and cannot with reasonable diligence be ascertained.

That the plaintiff is the owner in fee simple, and is in actual possession of the following described real property and premises, situated, lying and being in the County of Sublette, State of Wyoming, to-wit;

SE1/4NW1/4, SW1/4NE1/4, NE1/4SW1/4, NW1/4SE1/4 of Section 16, Twp. 39 North, 39 North, Range 110 West of the 6th P. M. together with the improvements thereon and the appurtenances thereunto belonging.

5. That for a continuous period of more than ten years last past, plaintiff has under a claim of ownership, been in open, notorious, exclusive, hostile, adverse, lawful, peaceable and actual possession of, and has owned ⁱⁿ fee simple, all of the above described real property and premises, during all of which time he asserted such ownership against the above named defendants, and against all of the world.
