KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Fremont Irrigation Company a corporation organized under the laws of the State of Wyoming, for and in consideration of Ten Dollars to it paid, receipt whereof is hereby confessed and acknowledged, does by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto Thomas Coats and Ada E Coats water from Pine Creek through the Highland Canal for the irrigation of the following described lands situate in Sublette County, Wyoming, to wit:

39 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and
40 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ all in
Section 24, Twp. 33 N., R. 109
West 6th P. M. Under Permit No. 8238

subject however, to the laws of the State of Wyoming, as to the amount of water applicable for the irrigation of said lands.

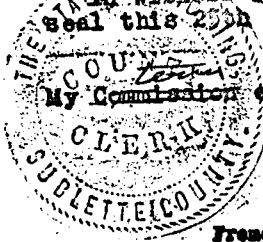
