

3. It is hereby further agreed, by and between the Parties to these presents, that the above covenants in each and every particular are to run with the land, and that they shall be construed as real covenants running with the land; and

4. It is hereby further agreed, by and between the Parties of these presents, that the above real covenants shall be perpetual until such time as they shall be terminated by mutual consent of the Party of the First Part and the Party of the Second Part hereto or their heirs and assigns.
