IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That there is hereby distributed to Margaret E. Binning five-tenths of all of the chattels of said estate, consisting of cattle, horses, machinery, vehicles and hay described in said inventory filed in said estate; that said five-tenths interest is to be selected from such portion of said chattels as said Margaret E. Binning shall determine under the provisions of said Will to take, based upon the value of the property selected, which value shall be that as set forth in said Inventory and Appraisement filed in said Estate.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that of the property subject to distribution there is hereby distributed to Burleigh Dean Binning and to Margaret Binning two-tenths interest each, including the real estate distributed to each of them, and to Margaret E. Binning as the Guardian of the Estate of Judy Ruth Story, a minor, one-tenth interest in the full value of said Estate, to be satisfied from the assets of said estate exclusive of real estate; that distribution is to be made by selecting said proportionate interest in the cattle based upon age, sex and value as determined in the appraisement of said estate, so that each will receive as near as is mathematically possible the number of the same type and species of cattle which each is to receive; and the ranch equipment, horses and hay, is hereby distributed on the same basis.
