VERIFICATION AND AFFIDAVIT

The above entitled matter came on regularly for hearing on the 25th day of June, A. D. 1930, the plaintiffs appearing by their attorneys E. A. Furman, Esq., (E. A. Christians, Esq. not appearing in person but being counsel of record), and H. Knight Wallace; the defendant appeared in person and by their attorneys G. H. Hedgett, Esq., Lewis H. Brown, Esq., and G. H. Hedgett, Esq.; from the files in the case, the evidence adduced on behalf of the parties and argument of counsel the Court finds generally for the plaintiffs and against the defendant; the Court further finds that the Oil, Gas and Mineral Lease dated the 5th day of November, 1922, between the parties hereto and covering the lands hereinafter described has been abandoned by the defendant and is void in all of its force or effect and the same should be cancelled and returned of record; that any and all claims or damages of the defendant against the plaintiffs in and to said lands are void and no such claim should be enforced and debarred from enforcement with all costs accruing; that plaintiffs should have judgment in such amount and for their costs herein incurred; and, the Court hereby orders so the parties.
