AGREEMENT

This Agreement made on the 17th day of November, A.D., 1945 by and between Helen Wilson, residing at Green River, Wyoming (herein called the party of the first part), and Woodrow Wilson, residing at Pinedale, Wyoming (herein called the second party).

Wherein it is mutually agreed, as follows:

1. That the First Party agrees to accept custody of minor child, Helen Jeanne, the issue of their marriage; to provide a decent and suitable home for her, to cloath and educate her until she graduates from high school.
2. That the Second Party agrees to forward to the First Party the sum of \$20.00 each and every month until said child shall attain the age of 21 years for the care of such child; Provided that should said First Party re-marry, then and in that event said sum of \$20.00 shall be deposited to the account of said minor child to be used either for educational purposes or to be turned over to her on her 21st birthday; And provided further that this agreement shall terminate on the event that said minor child should become deceased or married.


