

There being no other property or estate requiring administration the estate should be closed.

No objections have been made against the granting of the prayer of the petition of the husband of decedent to have set over to him all of the estate and property of the decedent; the prior order to show cause made by this Court has been duly and regularly published giving notice to persons interested of the time and place of hearing on the petition; and it is therefore, hereby

ORDERED that all of the estate and property of the decedent, now known or hereafter discovered, including, but not restricted to the following:

Lots numbered 9 and 10, in block numbered 4 of the Original Townsite of the Town of Pine-
dale, in the County of Sublette, State of Wyoming, as said lots and block are laid down and described on the official plat thereof of record in the office of the county clerk of said county,

is hereby set over to Edward Foster Claytor as his absolute property; and it is further, hereby

ORDERED that the above estate is closed, Edward Foster Claytor discharged as administrator and he and Massachusetts Bonding and Insurance Company released and relieved from further liability or accountability as principal and surety upon the bond of the administrator.
