

REVOCATION OF POWER OF ATTORNEY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That, WHEREAS, Stanolind Oil and Gas Company, a Delaware corporation, by Power of Attorney dated May 5, 1948, executed by A. L. Solliday, its Vice President, duly authorized by the Board of Directors of Stanolind Oil and Gas Company, did make, constitute, and appoint H. W.
