This cause came on regularly for trial before the court sitting without a jury on this day, upon the pleadings of plaintiffs and defendants herein filed; John S. Mackey appeared as attorney for plaintiffs and Lewis H. Brown by court appointment, appeared as attorney for defendant, and both sides having announced themselves ready for trial, and the court having heard the testimony and having examined the records in the case and the proofs offered, FINDS:

1. That each and all of the above named defendants have been duly and regularly served with summons and process by publication in the manner, and for the time, required by law; that each and all of said defendants defaulted in filing an Answer or other plea to plaintiffs' petition, and that their defaults were duly taken and entered.

2. That the plaintiffs have made and filed herein an affidavit stating that they have been unable to ascertain whether or not any of the above named defendants are in the military service of the United States, or are serving with the armed forces of any nation with which the United States is allied; that by virtue of said affidavit the court made and entered an order herein appointing Lewis H. Brown, a legal practicing attorney of this court, to represent all of the above named defendants in the trial of said action, and authorized and directed him
