GRANT OF EASEMENT FOR HIGHWAY

TO

WYOMING HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That the Board of Land Commissioners of the State of Wyoming, acting within the authority vested in it by and under the provisions of the Wyoming Compiled Statutes, doth grant to WYOMING HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT

for the uses and purposes and upon the conditions hereinafter set forth, a certain tract of land more particularly described as follows:
A strip of land for a highway Two Hundred feet (200') in width, being One Hundred feet (100') on each side of a center line across the South Half Northwest Quarter (SW¹/₄NW¹/₄) and Northeast Quarter Southwest Quarter (NE¹/₄SW¹/₄) of Section Sixteen (16), and Southwest Quarter Northeast Quarter (SW¹/₄NE¹/₄) and North Half Southeast Quarter (N¹/₂SE¹/₄) of Section Sixteen (16), Township Thirty (30) North, Range One Hundred Eleven (111) West, and the South Half South Half (S¹/₂S¹/₂) of Section Sixteen (16), Township Thirty (30) North, Range One Hundred Ten (110) West of the Sixth Principal Meridian, Sublette County, Wyoming, being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the west boundary of Section 16, T. 30 N., R. 111 W. from which the west one-quarter corner thereof bears S. 00°11' W. a distance of 380 feet; thence S. 79°43' E. a distance of 4692.9 feet to the point of beginning of a 0°30' curve to the left, the radius of which is 11459.2 feet; thence along said curve through a central angle of 3°37' for a distance of 723.8 feet to a point on the east boundary of said section from which the east one-quarter corner thereof bears N. 00°11' E. a distance of 298 feet; said parcel of land containing 24.9 acres, more or less.

Beginning at a point on the west boundary of Section 16, T. 30 N., R. 110 W. from which the southwest corner thereof bears S. 00°06' E. a distance of 165.3 feet; thence S. 79°36' E. a distance of 1207 feet, more or less, to a point on the south boundary of said section; said parcel of land containing 5.5 acres, more or less.

Beginning at a point on the south boundary of Section 16, T. 30 N., R. 110 W. from which the southeast corner thereof bears easterly a distance of 541 feet, more or less; thence N. 80°02' E. a distance of 229 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning of a 3°00' curve to the left, the radius of which is 1909.9 feet; thence along said curve through a central angle of 9°32' for a distance of 318 feet, more or less, to a point on the east boundary of said section from which the southeast corner thereof bears southerly a distance of 143 feet, more or less; said parcel of land containing 2.5 acres, more or less.
