

authorized and directed him to appear and defend said action in behalf of said defendants, said appointment having been made pursuant to the provision of the Soldiers' and Sailors' Relief Act; that the said Paul Ziegler by virtue of said appointment, has filed an answer herein, admitting some and denying other allegations of plaintiff's petition.

3. That the attorney for plaintiffs has also filed herein an affidavit for and in behalf of plaintiffs stating that the residence of defendant, Irwin E. Trout, also known as Erwin E. Trout is unknown and cannot with reasonable diligence be ascertained, and that the names and residences of the heirs, devisees and creditors of said Irwin E. Trout, also known as Erwin E. Trout and all persons unknown claiming an estate or interest in, or lien upon, the real property, which is the subject of this action, and particularly described in said petition, are still unknown to the plaintiffs and their attorney, and cannot with reasonable diligence be ascertained.

4. That the plaintiffs are the owners in fee simple, and are in actual possession of the following described real property and premises, situated, lying and being in the County of Sublette, State of Wyoming, to-wit:

Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) Section Twelve (12);
Township Thirty-two (32) North of Range
One Hundred Eight (108) West of the Sixth
(6th) Principal Meridian, Wyoming, together
with the improvements and appurtenances thereunto
belonging.

5. That for a continuous period of more than ten years last past, plaintiffs have under a claim of ownership, been in open, notorious, exclusive, hostile, adverse, lawful, peaceable and actual possession of, and have owned in fee simple, all of the above described real property and premises, during all of which time they asserted such ownership against the above named defendants, and against all of the world.
