Court on the 12th day of September, 1951, and that he thereupon gave notice to the creditors of said decedent in the manner and substance provided by law to present to him, or file with the Clerk of this Court their claims within six (6) months from the 14th day of September, 1951, the date of the first publication of said notice, and that said notice to creditors was published in the Kemmerer Gazette, a weekly newspaper printed and published at Kemmerer, in said County and State, for three (3) successive weekly issues thereof, and the time stated therein and limited by law for creditors to present and file their claims has expired, and all claims that have been presented and filed herein have been paid or otherwise duly disposed of, and that all costs, charges and expenses of administration of said estate, and all taxes levied and assessed against said estate, and all inheritance taxes and Federal Estate taxes have been paid and discharged; that on the 3rd day of October, 1951, said executor returned to this court and filed with the Clerk thereof, a true inventory and appraisement of the estate of said decedent, and that said estate has been fully administered and is now in condition to be closed and the residue thereof remaining in the possession and under the control of said executor is ready for distribution to the persons entitled thereto as expressed by the will of said decedent, and the Court, having fully considered the matter and proceedings herein had and the evidence adduced, finds:

Said account, report and petition to be true and correct; that Agnes Isabelle Twichel died testate and was a widow at the time of her death and left her surviving the following descendants, to-wit:

DOYLE TWICHEL, an adult son, and
