

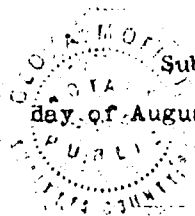

That at the time of the above conveyances, James Bertram and Florence Bertram, were husband and wife, and had been husband and wife for many years prior thereto and were husband and wife at the date of the death of James Bertram; that said deeds of conveyance and each of them to James Bertram, sometimes known as James W. Bertram, and Florence Bertram, husband and wife, created an estate by the entirety under the laws of the State of Wyoming, and upon the death of the said James Bertram, all the right, title, interest and claim of the said James Bertram in and to the above described real estate and premises ended and terminated, and the said Florence Bertram then became and is now the sole owner of said real estate and premises.
