This matter came on regularly to be heard, by the Court, this 8th day of September, A. D. 1952, upon the Petition of Daisy Dean Hicks, executrix, of the estate of Ralph Hicks, deceased, and surviving widow of Ralph Hicks, deceased, for an Order and Decree of Court, granting, awarding and setting over to her, as the surviving widow of Ralph Hicks, deceased, as her absolute property, certain real property, as a homestead, herein after described, belonging to said estate, which real property has been appraised in the Inventory and Appraisement herein filed at the sum of Four Thousand and no/100 (\$4,000.00) Dollars, and certain personal property, as exempt property, herein after described, belonging to said estate, which personal property has been appraised in the Inventory and Appraisement herein filed at the sum of Five Hundred and no/100 (\$500.00) Dollars, in accordance with and under and by virtue of Sections 6-1504 and 6-1505, Wyoming Compiled Statutes, 1945; and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Court that Notice of the hearing upon said Petition was given to all persons interested, in the manner and for the time required for by law, Proof of Publication of said notice having been filed herein, and that an Inventory and Appraisement has been returned and filed, and that no homestead or exempt property has been claimed by said surviving widow prior to or subsequent to the death of the said Ralph Hicks, deceased; and it further appearing to the Court that there are no minor children living, of the said Ralph Hicks and Daisy Dean Hicks, husband and wife, and it further appearing to the satisfaction of the Court that all expenses of administration, funeral expenses and expenses
