ORDER CONFIRMING SALE OF REAL ESTATE AND PERSONAL PROPERTY.

Now comes Walter Gurney, the administrator of the estate of Clifford D. Brown, deceased, by G. P. Hockett, his attorney, and proving to the satisfaction of the Court that this return of sale of real and personal property under the order of sale made by this Court on the 31st day of October, 1931; that thereafter this Court fixed Monday, the 13th day of June as the day for hearing thereof; that on said day and after examining the said return and hearing the evidence, the Court finds therefrom that said sale was legally made and fairly conducted; that the same was at private sale in the manner and form as prescribed by law and the said order of this Court; that the price obtained thereat was the reasonable value of the property sold, and that no greater sum can be obtained; that there are no objections thereto now higher bids therefor.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Court that the sale of the real and personal property in said return of sale and hereinafter described, to W. W. Clarkson, for the sum of Three Hundred and Three Dollars and Thirty-nine Cents (\$303.39) in cash, be and the same is hereby confirmed, and the said Walter Gurney, as administrator of the estate of said deceased, be and he is hereby directed to execute to said purchaser, W. W. Clarkson, a deed of conveyance thereof..

Said property is described as follows:

REAL ESTATE:

Lot Three, the Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (NE_{1/4}SW_{1/4}) and the West half of the Southeast quarter (W_{1/2}SE_{1/4}) of Section Nineteen (19) in Township 35 North of Range 113 West of the 6th Principal Meridian, Wyoming, containing 151.41 acres.

PERSONAL PROPERTY:

One saddle, blanket and bridle; one old watch; one cross cut saw; one pole axe; two log chains; one Malden wedge; One iron bed and bedding; one old cook stove; three kitchen chairs; one lot of kitchen utensils and dishes.
