

Sublette, CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned, all of whom are of the age of majority, for the purpose of organizing a corporation, pursuant to the laws of the State of Wyoming, do hereby adopt the following certificate of incorporation:

Article I.

The name of this Corporation shall be SUBLETTE COUNTY SPORTING ASSOCIATION, INCORPORATED.

Article II.

The general nature of its business shall be to aid the industrial or productive interests of the County of Sublette, State of Wyoming, without any purpose of direct gain to said Corporation.

To establish and maintain parks, grounds or race courses, for the trial of speeds, development or training of horses, with the right to offer and award premiums.

To establish and maintain parks or grounds for the exhibition of all kinds of live stock, agricultural, mechanical and mineral products, whether the products of this State or not, with the right to offer and award premiums.

To establish and maintain theatres, public halls, gardens, and other places of amusement, not prohibited by the laws of Wyoming.

Article III.

The principal place for the transaction of its business shall be the Town of Pinedale in the State of Wyoming.

Article IV.

This Corporation shall commence on the 22nd day of December, 1952, and continue thereafter for a period of Fifty years, but the period of its existence may be renewed from time to time, as provided by the laws of the State of Wyoming.

Article V.

The names of the persons forming this Corporation
