CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Leo Ball, ~~Henry~~ C. Dunham and Eva M. Nefcy, incorporators of the "Leoball Oil Company", affirm and state as follows:-

The name of the corporation shall be the "LEOBALL OIL COMPANY".

The object of the corporation shall be to conduct a general business of producing and marketing oil, gas, and other minerals and by-products in all its branches so far as permitted by the laws of any State in which such business shall be conducted and to pursue such subsidiary operations as permitted by law.

The term of existence of the corporation shall be fifty years.

The capital stock shall consist of \$250,000.00 divided into 1,000,000 shares of assessable common stock of a par value of twenty-five cents per share.

The principal place of business shall be in Labarge, Lincoln County, Wyoming.

The operations of the corporation will be carried on in Lincoln, Sublette Countys

The corporation will be managed and under control of three directors.
