IT IS FURTHER ADJUDGED, ORDERED, CONSIDERED AND DECREED, that said defendants, and each of them, be, and they are hereby forever restrained, enjoined and debarred from asserting any right, title, claim, estate, equity or interest whatsoever in or to said real property and premises, or any part thereof above described.
