That Plaintiffs' petition was filed in this Court on the 18th day of June, 1953, and on the same day a summons was duly issued out of and under the seal of this Court and returned not served by the Sheriff of Sublette County because the defendants could not be found in Sublette County; that the cause is one of the actions mentioned in section 8-1101, W. C. S., 1945, in that it is an action brought by Plaintiffs for the purpose of obtaining a decree declaring, determining and establishing the rights and interests of each and all of the Plaintiffs and Defendants in certain United States, State of Wyoming and individual oil and gas leases, the lands hereinafter
