It further appearing that Plaintiffs by their Petition seek to quiet title to the real property and interests therein and hereinafter described as against the several and separate claims of the defendants therein named and that no person exists who judgment should not now be entered against said defaulting defendants, and the Court having examined the evidence introduced by the Plaintiffs and being now fully advised in the premises finds generally for the Plaintiffs and against the said defendants upon the Plaintiffs' petition and against the defendants and for each of the Plaintiffs upon his separate cause of action and the issues of said cause; and the Court does further find that said Plaintiffs have sustained all the allegations of said petition by sufficient evidence; and the Court does finally find that the said defendants have no claim, right, title or interest of any kind to the real property and interests in said petition and hereinafter described.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED, DECREED AND DECREED that:

1. That at the time of the commencement of this action and at the time of hearing thereof, Plaintiff, Arthur S. Nelson, was and is the owner subject to overriding royalties of record of good and valid oil and gas leases covering lands in Teton County, Wyoming, issued by the State of Wyoming and certain individual fee owners with the right to explore and develop the said lands for oil, gas and other hydrocarbon substances; that the leases and the lands covered thereby are more particularly described as follows:
