That on April 17, 1946, Charles Wiederanders, a single man, conveyed by Warranty Deed to O. G. Jackson and Alma E. Jackson, husband and wife, the following described real estate situate in Sublette County, in the State of Wyoming, to-wit:

Lots 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13 and 14, in Block 8, of the Jones Addition to the Town of Pinedale.

That said conveyance was duly recorded in the office of the County Clerk and Ex-Officio Register of Deeds of Sublette County, Wyoming, on the 17th day of April, 1946, in Book 4 of Deeds at page 614.

That on the 4th day of June, 1946, Jennie Jones, a widow woman, conveyed by Warranty Deed to O. G. Jackson and Alma E. Jackson, his wife, as joint tenants, the following described real estate situate in Sublette County, in the State of Wyoming, to-wit:

Lot 19, in Block 4, of the Original Townsite of the Town of Pinedale, Wyoming.

That said deed of conveyance was duly recorded in the office of the County Clerk and Ex-Officio Register of Deeds of Sublette County, Wyoming, on the 10th day of June, 1946, in Book 4 of Deeds at page 632.

That on September 9, 1943, George W. Hubbard, a widower, conveyed by Warranty Deed to O. G. Jackson and Alma E. Jackson, the following described real estate situate in Sublette County, in the State of Wyoming, to-wit:
