DECREE APPROVING FIRST AND FINAL ACCOUNT TOGETHER  
WITH SUPPLEMENT THERETO AND PROVIDING FOR DISTRIBUTION.

Jennie Fronk, as Executrix of the Estate of Hearley Fronk, Deceased, having heretofore filed herein her First and Final Account, together with Petition for Distribution, and having now filed herein her Supplementary Account, and said accounting and petition coming on regularly to be heard this day in open court, and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Court that the Executrix has heretofore published notice to all creditors and other persons interested in said Estate, and notice of final settlement of said Estate, which notices were published for the time and in the manner prescribed by law, and no objections or exceptions to said accounting having been made or filed herein by any person interested in said Estate, or otherwise,

And it appearing to the satisfaction of the Court from the evidence adduced at said hearing, that the First and Final Account and Supplement thereto is in all respects just, true and correct and should be settled as rendered, and that all and singular, the allegations and statements contained in said Petition for Final Settlement and Distribution is and are true, and the Court finds them to be true, and that all taxes levied against the property and assets of said Estate have been paid by the Executrix, and that all claims and debts against and owing by said decedent, and all debts, expenses and charges of administration have been fully paid and discharged, except as herein stated, to-wit:

1. Fees and commissions due to Jennie Fronk, Executrix, for services rendered in the administration of said Estate.

2. Fees due to C. A. Brimmer for legal services rendered as Attorney for the Executrix in the administration of said Estate, together with the sum of \$1.00 advanced to the Inheritance Tax Commissioner.

3. Court Costs.

And it further appearing that the said Hearley Fronk died testate on the 15th day of December, 1947 at his ranch home near Bondurant in Sublette County, Wyoming, and was at the time of his death a resident of the County of Sublette, and State of Wyoming, and left real and personal property in said County and State; that at the time of his death he was engaged in the ranching and cattle business with his two sons, Vincent T. Fronk and Daniel Fronk; that the said ranching and cattle business was known and operated as the Bar H F Ranch, and was in the nature of a family partnership; that the family of the decedent and the families of the decedent's sons, Vincent T. Fronk and Daniel Fronk, resided upon said ranching premises and conducted the said ranching and cattle business, and the said three families received their livelihood from the said business;
