

his heirs, executors, administrators or assigns as aforesaid, or in any other way, the said party of the second part, his executors, administrators, do hereby covenant and agree to surrender and deliver up the said above described premises and property peaceably to said party of the first part, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, immediately upon the termination of said term as aforesaid, and if he shall remain in possession of the same three days after notice of such default, or after the termination of this Lease in any of the ways above named he shall be deemed guilty of forcible detainer of said premises under the statute, and shall be subject to conditions and provisions above named, and to eviction and removal, forcible or otherwise, with or without process of law as above stated.
