That the plaintiff is a fit and proper person to have the care, maintenance and custody of the minor children and that they should be awarded to the custody of the plaintiff;

That the plaintiff and defendant jointly own and hold as tenants by the entirety certain real estate situate in the Town of Pinedale, Wyoming, and more particularly described as Lots 3 and 4 in Block 14, of the Hannick Addition to the Town of Pinedale, Wyoming, as said lots are laid down and described on the duly recorded plat of said Addition in the office of the Clerk of Sublette County, Wyoming, and that the same should be set over to the plaintiff as her absolute property, free and clear of any and all right, title, claim or equity of the defendant therein;

That the defendant has offered such indignities to the plaintiff as to render the plaintiff's condition in life as the wife of the defendant intolerable, and that she should be granted a divorce from the defendant.

WHEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court that the marriage now existing between the plaintiff and defendant be, and the same is hereby dissolved and terminated, and the plaintiff, Edith L. Bush, be and she hereby is granted and decreed an ABSOLUTE DIVORCE from the defendant, Joe H. Bush, and the parties hereto are restored to the status of single persons;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the said minor children, Gary Albert Bush, Linda Elizabeth Bush and Judith Rebecca Bush, are hereby awarded to the care and custody of the plaintiff herein, Edith L. Bush, with the provision that the defendant shall have the right and privilege of visiting them at all proper and reasonable times;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that a fee simple title in and to Lots 3 and 4 in Block 14 of the Hannick Addition to the Town of Pinedale, Wyoming, as said lots are laid down and described on the duly recorded plat of said Addition in the office of the Clerk of Sublette County, Wyoming, be transferred and set over, and the same are hereby transferred and set over unto the plaintiff, Edith L. Bush, as her absolute property, free and clear of all right, title, claim, equity and interest of the Defendant therein.
