

my trustees shall transfer, convey and distribute said trust estate, including any accrued and/or unused and/or accumulated income, share and share alike, to Edward G. Girard and Marion Baker Girard of Alhambra, California, or to the survivor of them. (c) If either or both of the said John Baker Girard and Donald Edward Girard die before termination of the trust, either or both leaving issue surviving, then the share of the principal and income of the deceased party or parties shall go to his or their issue, per stirpes and not per capita; however, if one of the parties named should survive the other but die before termination of the trust, leaving no issue surviving him, then his share of the principal and income shall be distributed, share and share alike to the issue of the predeceased party. The trustees may in the case of illness, accident or in the matter of a college or university education for the said John Baker Girard and Donald Edward Girard draw upon accumulated income and upon the corpus of the trust estate; however, such an invasion of the accumulated income or corpus shall be considered an advancement and, upon distribution of the corpus, the amount of the advancement shall be deducted from the share of the person receiving it. All in accordance with the terms and provisions of the Last Will and Testament and Codicil thereto of the deceased admitted to probate herein. 457.

5. That the interest of the said John Baker Girard and Donald Edward Girard be and the same is hereby declared to be not subject to claims of their creditors or others, nor to legal process, nor to encumbrance, voluntary or otherwise, nor to alienation, voluntary or otherwise.

6. That the said executor be and he is hereby discharged, and he and his bondsmen are hereby released from further liability, and the administration of the said estate is hereby declared terminated.
