This matter having come on regularly for hearing, on the Petition to
set aside Homestead herein filed, and the Order to Show Cause of this
Court, dated the 30th day of July, 1955, said Order to Show Cause having
been published in the Pinedale Roundup, Pinedale, Wyoming for three (3)
successive weeks, and the Court having examined the records and heard the
evidence offered, the Court finds as follows:

1. That the Petitioner, Susie C. Yarger is the widow of Walter F. Yarger, sometimes known as W. F. Yarger, deceased, and as such widow, is entitled to have an order of this Court setting over to her the homestead of the deceased, Walter F. Yarger, sometimes known as W. F. Yarger.
2. That, at the time of Walter F. Yarger's demise, he was a householder in the State of Wyoming, being the head of a family, and also a resident of the State of Wyoming over the age of 60 years, namely of the age of 66 years; that said decedent was married to and living with the Petitioner, Susie C. Yarger, as husband and wife, at the time of his demise; that said decedent, Walter F. Yarger, sometimes known as W. F. Yarger, and said Susie C. Yarger were living in the residence owned by said Walter F. Yarger, sometimes known as W. F. Yarger, located in the Town of Daniel, Wyoming at the time of his demise; that there are no minor children of said decedent; that the value of said residence, together with all personal property belonging to said decedent, at the time of his demise, which constitutes all of the property subject to probate in the above entitled cause, as determined by the appraisers duly appointed by this Court, does not exceed the sum of Four Thousand and 00/100 (\$4,000.00) Dollars, having been appraised at the value of Three Thousand Four Hundred Eighty and 00/100 (\$3,480.00) Dollars.
3. That all expenses of administration, expenses of the last sickness and funeral expenses have been paid; that the sum of Two Hundred Twenty-four and 00/100 (\$224.00) Dollars is a reasonable and legal attorney fee, for services rendered to executrix in the probate of said estate; that there
