MEYER, and the unknown heirs and devisees of any of the above named individual defendants who may be deceased.

It further appearing that Plaintiff by its Petition seeks to quiet title to the real property and interests therein and hereinafter described as against the several and separate claims of the Defendants therein named and that no reason exists why judgement should not now be entered against said defaulting defendants, and against The Superior Oil Company, who has filed its disclaimer herein, and the Court having examined the evidence adduced by the Plaintiff and now being fully advised in the premises finds generally for the Plaintiff and against the said Defendants upon the Plaintiff's Petition; and the Court does further find that said Plaintiff has sustained all the allegations of said Petition by sufficient evidence; and the Court does finally find that the said Defendants, and each of them, have no claim, right, title or interest of any kind to the real property and interests in said Petition and hereinafter described.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, DECLARED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED:

1. That at the time of the commencement of this action and at the time of hearing thereof, Plaintiff, Belco Petroleum Corporation, a corporation, was and is the owner of a good and valid oil and gas lease covering lands in Sublette County, Wyoming, issued by certain individual fee owners, with the right to explore and develop the said lands for oil, gas and other hydrocarbon substances; that the lease and lands covered thereby are more particularly described as follows:

2. That the right, title, interest and estate of the Plaintiff, as hereinabove declared and adjudicated, in and to said lands, said oil, gas and other hydrocarbon substances and the said lease, be and the same hereby
