DECREE OF FINAL SETTLEMENT OF ACCOUNT

AND DECREE OF DISTRIBUTION

That it further appearing that the above named Mary Price, wife, and heirs, to-wit, to be the executrix of the estate of Alexander Price, Sr., also known as A. L. Price, Alex L. Price, and Alex Price, deceased, having heretofore rendered and filed herein a full account and report of her administration of said estate, which account was for a final settlement, and having with said account filed a petition for the distribution of the residue of said estate;

And the said account and petition this day coming on regularly to be heard, proof having been made to the satisfaction of the Court that notice of the settlement of said account and hearing of said petition has been given in the manner and for the time in such cases required by law;

And it appearing that said account is in all respects true and correct, and that all claims and debts, expenses and charges of administration, have been fully paid and discharged, and that said estate is now ready for distribution and in condition to be closed;

And it further appearing that Alexander Price, Sr., also known as Alex L. Price, and Alex Price, deceased, died testate on the 29th day of September, 1952; that his last will and testament admitted to probate herein provided as follows:

"FIRST

I direct that my executrix shall, as soon as practicable after my death, pay all of my just debts.

SECOND

I GIVE AND DEVISE all of my estate, both real and personal, of every name and nature whatsoever, owned by me at the time of my death, to my wife, Mary Price, and my three sons, Ellis Clayton Price, age 25 years, Clarence Douglas Price, age 24 years, and Alexander Price, Jr., age 19 years, to be divided equally between them, share and share alike."
