DECREE OF DIVORCE

The above entitled action came on for hearing before the Court this day upon the petition of George M. Austin praying that his marriage to defendant, Evelyn L. Austin, be dissolved, and that he be restored to the status of a single person, and praying further for an equal division by the Court of a certain oil, gas and mineral estate, jointly owned by the parties to this proceeding; and the plaintiff appearing in person and by his attorney, and the defendant having filed her answer herein and having waived notice of the time and place of hearing upon the plaintiff's petition; and the Court having examined the pleadings filed herein and heard the evidence and testimony offered in behalf of the defendant, and the Court being advised in the premises, FINDS:

That the defendant has filed herein an answer to the petition of the plaintiff and has by her waiver, also filed herein, waived notice of the time and place of hearing upon the plaintiff's petition;

That the plaintiff was at the time of filing this petition herein and commencing this action a resident of the County of Sublette and State of Wyoming, and that he had resided in said State and County for a period of more than sixty days preceding the filing of said petition;

That the plaintiff and defendant were married on the 9th day of March, 1949, at Billings, Montana, and that they were at the time of filing this action husband and wife, and that no children have been born to them as a result of this marriage;

That the plaintiff and defendant jointly own an undivided one-half part and interest in and to the oil and gas and other minerals contained in, upon and under the lands and real estate hereinafter described:
