
AFFIDAVIT OF ATTORNEY

Kenneth G. Hamm, of lawful age, being first duly sworn upon his oath according to law, deposes and says:

1. That he is an attorney admitted generally to practice law within the State of Wyoming; that he is one of the attorneys for The Rock Springs National Bank, a United States banking corporation; that said The Rock Springs National Bank is foreclosing a mortgage, dated April 27, 1949, made, executed and delivered by Edward J. Kermanen and Mrs. Signe Kermanen, his wife, as mortgagors, to The Rock Springs National Bank, a United States banking corporation, as mortgages, which mortgage deed was recorded in the office of the County Clerk and Ex-Officio Register of Deeds of Sublette County, Wyoming, on May 4, 1949, in Book 5 of Mortgages on Page 610; and that he is representing said The Rock Springs National Bank in said foreclosure.

2. That there is not, nor has there been, any agreement, express or implied, between him or his client, nor between him and any other person except practicing attorneys of the State of Wyoming engaged with him as attorneys in said foreclosure proceedings, for any sharing or division of said attorney fee of \$1,490.11, to be allowed and added to the debt involved, and any fee, when so allowed and added to the debt, is only as compensation for services actually rendered in said foreclosure proceedings.
