 GRANT OF EASEMENT BY George E. Gilligan AND Ada M. Gilligan, COUNTY CLERK
 SUELETTE COUNTY, PINEDALE, WYOMING

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

THAT George E. Gilligan and Ada M. Gilligan, husband and wife of Suelette County, State of Wyoming, parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and other valuable considerations, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted and conveyed, and by these presents do grant and convey unto LINCOLN SERVICE CORPORATION, a Corporation, of Frontier, Lincoln County, Wyoming, party of the second part, its successors and assigns, an EASEMENT for a right of way to place, construct, operate, repair and maintain an electric transmission or distribution line or system with necessary appurtenances thereto, over, under, through, across and upon the following described property of the parties of the first part, located in Suelette County, State of Wyoming, to-wit:

Sections 24, 25, T. 33 N., R. 106 W., C.P.T.T.P. lines
To house is to follow fence line that runs
East and West, South of River road running
into house. Objet to keep poles out of
Meadow.

Said parties of the first part, their heirs, legal representatives and assigns shall have full use and enjoyment of the said premises except for the uses and purposes hereinbefore granted. The said party of the second part shall have full right of ingress and egress to and from said described lands for the purpose of exercising the rights herein granted.

This grant of easement shall at all times be deemed to be, and shall be a continuing covenant running with the land and shall be binding upon the heirs, legal representatives and assigns of the parties of the first part.
