RIGHT-OF-WAY DEED

THIS INDENTURE, made this 17 day of January in the year one thousand nine hundred and 1916, by and between

Abner L. Hecox and Edna Lee Hecox, his Wife,
and
Richard D. Hecox and Dorothy I. Hecox, his Wife,

of the County of Sublette, in the State of Wyoming, Grantors,
parties of the first part, and Sublette County, of the State of Wyoming,
Grantee, party of the second part:

WITNESSETH: That, for and in consideration of the sum of Two Thousand Two Hundred Forty-Five & forty-two hundredths dollars (\$ 2215.42), to them in hand paid, and other valuable considerations, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties of the first part do hereby grant bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto Sublette County, of the State of Wyoming, an easement and right-of-way in gross over the following tracts of land, situate, lying and being in the County of Sublette, State of Wyoming, and particularly described as follows:

Section 26
Section 25
Section 13
Section 24
Section 21

All of T. 37 N., R. 110 W., 6th P.M.

The said right-of-way hereby granted is for the construction, maintenance, and full, free and quiet use and enjoyment by Sublette County, of the State of Wyoming, for any and all purposes by them desired or deemed necessary or beneficial, and by the general public as a public highway of a certain road or way, being 100 feet in width, and traversing the above described premises by the following general courses and distances, to-wit:

Within E1/2 Sec. 26 and W1/2 Sec. 25.
beginning at a point on the south boundary of the Grantors' land; which is S. 89°50' W. 375.4 feet from the 1/4 corner common to Sections 26 and 25, T. 37 N., R. 110 W., 6th P.M., and which is station 35+59.3 of the Centerline Survey; thence N. 52°50' E. for 261.9 feet; thence on a 1500 ft. radius curve to the right for 104.0 feet; thence S. 68°16' E. for 623.0 feet; thence on a 1700 ft. radius curve to the left for 600.8 feet, more or less, to station 55+48.0 of the Centerline Survey, said point being on the East boundary of the Grantors' land, having a total length of 1983.7 feet and containing 4.56 acres, more or less.
