

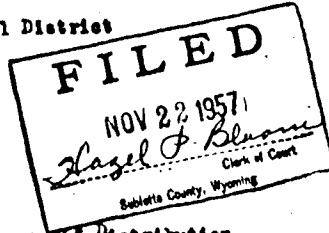

Order Settling Administrator's Account and Degree of Distribution

George A. Moffat, as administrator of the above estate, having on the 12th day of October, 1957, filed herein a full account and report of his administration of said estate, which account was for final settlement, and having therewith filed his petition for distribution of said decedent's estate, and said account and petition this day coming on regularly to be heard, and the Court having heard and examined the evidence and proofs offered in support thereof, does find:

That notice to all creditors and others interested in the above estate was published for four consecutive weeks in the Pinedale Roundup, a newspaper published and of general circulation in the County of Sublette and State of Wyoming, the first publication thereof appearing therein on the 26th day of September, 1957, and advising that said administrator would file his final account and petition for distribution of said estate in the office of the Clerk of the above Court on or before the 21st day of October, 1957, and that he would make final settlement of the above estate on the 1st day of November, 1957, unless objections to the account and petition were filed on or before the 31st day of October, 1957;

That copies of the notice of the final settlement of said estate were addressed to the heirs and devisees of the deceased at their places of residence, and deposited in the United States Post Office at Pinedale, Wyoming, with the postage thereon prepaid as required by law;

That no objections to said account and petition have been filed herein by any heir, or creditor of the decedent or his estate, or any other interest/person;

That said account is in all respects true and correct and that it is supported by proper vouchers and cancelled checks, and that the residue of money in the hands of the administrator at the time of filing said account was \$10,033.02, that since the rendition of said account no additional money has been received and no additional expenditures made; that the sum of \$5000.00 should be distributed to all of the decedent's heirs, except Charles Herbert Alexander, in equal shares, and that the residue of \$5033.02 be reserved for the payment of such income taxes as may yet be found due and owing, administrator's commission, attorney fees, and other expenses incidental to the closing of said estate and to be accounted for herein;
