



This cause coming on this day to be heard before  
 me, H. R. Christmas, Judge of the said Court, upon the peti-  
 tion of Donald W. Jewett for the removal of the disabilities  
 of Donald Richard Noble as a minor, and praying that the said  
 Donald Richard Noble be declared of full age for all legal  
 intents and purposes and to be capacitated to transact all  
 business for himself the same as an adult, except as to the  
 right to vote; and it appearing to the Court upon the proofs  
 taken at said hearing that said minor is now twenty (20) years  
 of age, and that he is the owner of an undivided interest in  
 certain real property situate in Sublette County, Wyoming;  
 that your petitioner, Donald W. Jewett, is the Uncle of the  
 above-named minor, and that the parents of said minor are  
 both now deceased; that a legal guardian was heretofore appoint-  
 ed for the above-named minor, but was by the order of this  
 Court, entered on the 10th day of January, 1957, was released  
 and discharged as such, and the said minor does not now have  
 a legal guardian; that the said minor is conversant with the  
 English language and understands the methods of business as  
 commonly practiced in this community, and is qualified and  
 competent to attend to business for himself, the same as any  
 other adult; that the said minor is now a member of the armed  
 forces of the United States, and is presently stationed at
