KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that Sam R. Robinson, assignor herein, of Pinedale, in the County of Sublette and State of Wyoming, and for and in consideration of the sum of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars and other good and valuable considerations, the payments and receipt of which from Paul W. Huish and Bernice V. Huish, husband and wife, of Salt Lake City, Utah, assignee herein, is hereby acknowledged, has assigned, sold, quitclaimed, set over and transferred, and by these presents does assign, sell, quitclaim, set over and transfer forever, unto Paul W. Huish and Bernice V. Huish, husband and wife, with full rights of survivorship, and as Tenants of an estate by the Entireties, and their heirs and assigns, all of his right, title, interest and equity in and to that certain "Special Use Permit" issued by the United States Department of Agriculture under date of March 21, 1956, acting through the Forest Service and bearing the signature of J. L. Sawyer, Forest Supervisor, in and to the following described lands:

Lot 8, Block 3 of Lower Fremont Lake group of summer home sites, as shown on map and survey of this group made by Ranger A. P. Russell, 5/8-10/16. Area contains .30 acres. Together with the frame construction residential building, the same be described as a summer home, and Boat House and Boat Dock, Water System and other improvements situate thereon and appurtenant thereto.

I agree to sign any other or additional papers or instruments necessary to the release and conveyance of all of my right, title, interest and equity in and to the above described property and "Special Use Permit". I hereby specifically represent that the above premises are not used by myself and wife, or claimed by either of us, as a homestead, as that word is used and intended in the Wyoming Homestead Laws.
