Young, widow of said deceased, and also the following named minor children, to-wit: Eva Ann Mills, William Stephen Mills, Lawrence Mills and Clara May Mills; and that the said family of said deceased is entitled to have the whole of said estate set apart for the use and support of said family;

And all and singular, the law and the evidence being by the Court considered and understood; and said administratrix having heretofore filed a petition praying that a decree heretofore entered herein on the 28th day of February, 1919, be modified to correspond with the above findings of this Court; It is Therefore,

CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED, that said decree of this Court heretofore entered herein on the 28th day of February, 1919, be set aside and be of no effect; that all that certain lot, piece or parcel of land described in said petition, as situate, lying and being in the County of Lincoln, State of Wyoming, and hereinafter particularly described, to-wit:

Lot numbered Eleven (11) in Block Thirteen (13) in the Town of Big Piney, according to the official plat of the said Town now on file and of record in the office of the County Clerk and Ex-Officio Register of Deeds in and for said County, together with the buildings thereon, together with its appurtenances, pool tables and furniture

being all the property belonging to the estate of said deceased, be, and the same is hereby set apart to the said family of said deceased, as their sole and absolute property, and that the same shall not be subject to administration; and it is further ordered that a certified copy of this Decree be recorded in the office of the County Clerk and Ex-Officio Register of Deeds in and for said County.
