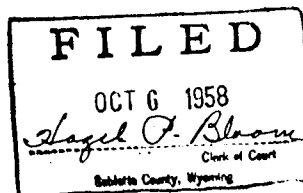

J U D G M E N T

The above cause came on regularly for hearing on the 3 day of October, 1958, before the Honorable H. R. Christmas, Judge, and the plaintiff appearing by his attorney, Robert W.
