
JUDGMENT

The above cause came on regularly for hearing on the 5
day of October, 1958, before the Honorable H. R. Christmas, Judge,
and the plaintiff appearing by his attorney, Robert W. Sievers,
and the defendants not appearing in person or by attorney, and the
Court having examined the service of process and being now fully
advised in the premises, finds:

That the plaintiff's petition was filed in this court on the
30 day of July, 1958, and on the same day a summons was duly
issued out of and under the seal of this court; that said
summons was returned, not served, for the reason that none of the
above named defendants could be found within the County of
Sublette, State of Wyoming.

The cause is one of the actions mentioned in Section 3-1101,
W. C. S. 1945, as supplemented by rule 4 (e) (4) Wyoming Rules of
Civil Procedure, in that it is an action brought by plaintiff
for the purpose of obtaining a decree declaring, determining and
establishing the rights and interest of the plaintiff as
established against the claims and demands of the defendants herein;
that service of summons issued out of this court was duly and
regularly made by publication upon the remaining defendants;

That the defendants, and each of them, have failed in any
manner to answer plaintiff's summons, served and published as
