

Chattel Mortgage

This is a chattel mortgage to secure the payment of a promissory note of even date herewith, for
--Two Thousand Seven Hundred Ten Dollars and Eight Cents ----- DOLLARS
signed by said mortgagor and payable to the order of said mortgagee as specified after date
at Salt Lake City, Utah in said Salt Lake County, Utah,
with reasonable Dollars attorney's fee for collections.

Said property may remain in the possession of the mortgagor subject to the conditions herein
mentioned; but he agreed that he will not remove the same from the place where it now is.

If default be made in the payment of said note, or if sale or removal of said property be made
or attempted, said mortgagee may take possession of said property wherever found, using all
necessary force for that purpose, and may proceed to foreclose. And is hereby fully authorized and
empowered to sell and dispose of the same at public auction, by advertisement, according to the
law in such case made and provided.

Should the proceeds from such sale fail to satisfy this mortgage, costs and expenses, then the
mortgagor agreed to pay the deficiency.

For the purpose of obtaining the above loan, the mortgagor represents that he
the owner of said property, and that the same is free from all liens and incumbrances, except those
specifically given to or told to the Mortgagee.
